The Mesa County Coroner's Office has completed its examination regarding the death of Brent E. Ingram, a 39 year-old male resident of Grand Junction. Mr. Ingram was involved in an altercation with Grand Junction Police Department officers and sustained multiple gunshot wounds (two) during the incident and died at the scene. The cause of death is multiple gunshot wounds of the chest and the manner of death is Homicide. In this case, the use of the word "Homicide" strictly relates to its definition; the killing of one human being by another. Classifying this death as Homicide does not infer any culpability on the part of law enforcement.

The law enforcement agencies overseeing this investigation are the Mesa County Sheriff's Office and the District Attorney's Office. Please contact them for any further details regarding this case. This is an ongoing investigation and the Mesa County Coroner's Office will provide no further information regarding this incident.
