The Mesa County Coroner's Office has completed its examination regarding the death of Norman "Norm" L. Gambrell, a 70-year-old male resident of Grand Junction. Mr. Gambrell had been hunting in the DeBeque area for the past week. Mr. Gambrell had an advanced disease process that led to his death. The ATV on which he was riding did not injure him in any way. The **Cause of Death** was **Ischemic Heart Disease** and the **Manner of Death** was **Natural**. Mr. Gambrell recently spoke with his wife about when he died, he would like to be hunting. The family has told this office they are finding great comfort in knowing Mr. Gambrell died doing what he loved.
