The Mesa County Coroner's Office has completed its examination regarding the death of Tiana Williams a 21-year-old female resident of Grand Junction, CO. Williams was the female passenger involved in the dune buggy rollover in the desert off of 27 ¼ Rd, Grand Junction, CO. The cause of death is blunt force head injuries and the manner of death is accident. She was not wearing a helmet but was wearing a lap belt. Toxicology was negative as well.

The law enforcement agency overseeing this investigation is the Mesa County Sheriff's Office because the rollover wasn't on a defined roadway. Please contact them for any further details regarding this case.
