The Mesa County Coroner's Office has completed its examination regarding the death of Scott Burke, a 43-year-old male resident of Craig, CO. Mr. Burke was the person reported missing earlier this week. He was found in a remote area of Mesa County on September 30, 2016. Due to the circumstances, the cause and the manner of death is pending toxicology, however, there is nothing suspicious at this time. Toxicology will take up to six weeks to get results.
