The Mesa County Coroner's Office has completed its examination regarding the death of Alex Head, a 17-year-old male resident of Clifton, CO. Mr. Head was the young man that was pulled under the water in the 32 Rd area of the Colorado River when he swung from a rope under a bridge on the evening of July 6, 2016. He was the male pulled from the Colorado River in the Loma area on July 10, 2016. The cause of death is drowning and the manner of death is accident.
